Holle all!

Has been a great season already and we have made some changes that is making things easier on myself and the coaches. We also have a lot going on with our bikes. By the time this gets to you, we should have the 4 Royal Enfields that we ordered. We are putting engine guards on them to help protect them more. However, they are tall bikes and you cannot get manufacture lowering kits. We have to use manufacturer ones.

This means that we will be selling off some of the taller bikes, like the Nighthawks and our only TU. If your ever at Head Motor Company next to Mid America HD, stop in and tell them thanks. They are not getting a penny from the sale of these Bikes. They are also working with me, and there is a possibility that we will have a Can Am program next year.

That means will have Can Am student loaners. Head Motor Company isn't getting the business that they were hoping for, since they are supporting a site in Kansas City. He tells me that he can fill 2 or 3 3WBRCU classes for us. Still checking into all of it like storage and such, but I am hopeful.

Wish I had better news for you guys that are wanting our Rebel's and Eliminators. Most manufactures are not making the smaller training bikes. The Royal Enfields we are getting are 350 cc. Us coaches like the Eliminators for the students over the Rebels. It's a shifting thing, however the mechanics like the Rebels better cause the parts are cheaper and they are so easy to work on. As I write this, our mechanic thinks he knows what the problem is and said we may be better off keeping the Eliminators. But before we can sell off more than a couple of bikes, we need to make sure we can shorter replacements.

I have borrowed 2 coaches from Ft. Lenordwood. One is retiring before the season ends, and the other will change duty stations at some point. I do have 4 people possibly interested in being coaches, so I am getting them the information they need to start that journey. If you are interested in being a coach, or just want more information, please contact me. It pays well for a weekend job and you only have to do 3 classes every 2 years to keep your certification. We pay for your hotel room to come coach.
