A motion was made by L 11 and 2nd by L 30 to not to completely shut down the original website until the new website is completed. After much discussion, motion passed with 21 yea, 2 no and 1 abstain.

<u>Awareness Coordinator</u> – Heather Peterson. Taking over the Dial-A-Ride will have more information next meeting. Booth for Lake of Ozarks Bike Fest planning in progress. Any ideas, contact Heather

<u>Legislative Coordinator</u> – Redistricting clogged up most of the session. They will be back May 18th. FORR endorsed Eric Burlison. Mike Moon is also running, he is a friend of ours. A motion was made by L1 and 2nd

by L 5 to send a \$500.00 contribution to the election of Shane Rhoden. With no discussion, motion passed by a unanimous roll call vote. MAY rally was a success. Need to start having a theme for the rally so the legislators have a topic to focus on for discussion. Need to start looking at what FORR would like to support for next year. This is an election year, support candidates in your area by putting up billboards, sign etc.

<u>MRF</u> – Meeting of the Minds will be held in Missouri in 2024. MRF topics covered are profiling, blended fuels and autonomous vehicles.

<u>Mid-South Mile</u> – Will be held in Topeka, KS Oct 7-9 at Ramada Inn. Missouri will be hosting MSM in 2023 in Branson.

Motion passed with 17 yea, 8 no and 1 abstain, with some discussion.

A NOTE FROM THE EVENTS/ INSURANCE COORDINATOR

Events:

I am glad to see additional interest, in constructing flyers and filling out Sanction Forms, by long term, short term or even new members. An informative letter is sent with Event Waivers. I encourage these volunteers to read it. It would be helpful to get the signed waivers sent to me in a timely manner. There are some locals that still haven't returned waivers from events of last year.

Another little item is the Rain Date. Some locals put a rain Date on their flyer and sanction form. If they cancel their event, they need to notify me so I can inform the insurance company. The company needs to know if the local is using the rain date.

Insurance:

In 2021, the Insurance Company, that carries the coverage for Freedom of Road Riders®, Inc, changed their structure. They added an additional premium to events added through the year. They wanted \$100.00 each event. Bob negotiated with them and got it reduced to \$50.00. He adjusted the amounts the locals paid for each event they sponsor: \$75.00 (One day event) \$150.00 (Rallies, 500 or less in attendance) \$200.00 (Rallies over 500 in attendance).

This year, the company wanted the \$100.00. Brad, our Insurance Agent and I were only able to get it reduced to \$90.00 each event. Therefore, the locals need to pay more for each event, to relieve the organization of some of the burden of the insurance bills.

I am proposing increasing:

One day Events to \$85.00; Rallies, 500 or less to \$165.00; Rallies over 500 to \$225.00.

When Bob took care of it, he chose those figures for a balance between the locals and the organization's finances.

As the Event Coordinator, I am the person between Locals/ Organization and Agent/Insurance Brokerage House.

MRF Report



International Motorcycling Advocate Deb Butitta Killed in Arizona Crash

It is with a heavy heart and a great sense of loss that the Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) shares the passing of Deborah Butitta. Deb had been committed to serving and protecting motorcyclists' rights at the state, federal and international levels during the last four decades. Deb was taken from us due to internal injuries suffered in a motorcycle crash after a truck turned left in front of her on June 3, 2022.

Deb was particularly active with ABATE of Arizona, holding many different offices through the years, and in 2001 was selected as the first designated lobbyist for the Arizona Confederation of Motorcycle Clubs (AZCMC). Deb was a member of many state motorcyclists' rights organizations, including the MMA of Arizona. She also served on the MRF Board of Directors for many years and was instrumental in the formation of MRF A&E (Awareness and Education), a 501(c)(3) charitable, non-profit organization created to assist the MRF in providing resources to promote motorcycle awareness and 'share the road' programs, along with all aspects of motorcycle safety education including rider training. A highly successful businesswoman in her own right, Deb was extremely well connected, not only in the motorcycling community and industry, but legislatively and in some very influential social circles as well. These relationships were of incredible value to the bikers of Arizona and the entire country.

Deb's accolades and awards are many, including being inducted into the MRF Hall of Fame in 2020 and the Sturgis Hall of Fame and Museum in 2021. Deb is a past winner of the MRF President's Cup (2003), the MRF Founder's Award (2017), and the MRF Lifetime Achievement Award (2020). Among her many other duties, Deb served as the MRF's State Representative for Arizona for 14 years. For several years now, the MRF has given the 'Deborah Butitta Award' to it's highest performing State Representative in her honor.

A true leader, Deb had a profound influence on many of her fellow activists. Few people have dedicated so much of their life or contributed as much to motorcycling as Deb Butitta. Personally and professionally, her passing leaves a tremendous void in our "family".
