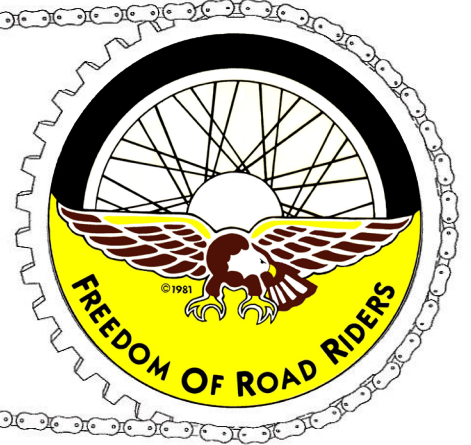

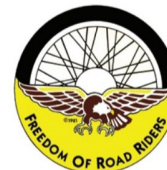

Hello Motorcycle Lover and Fans

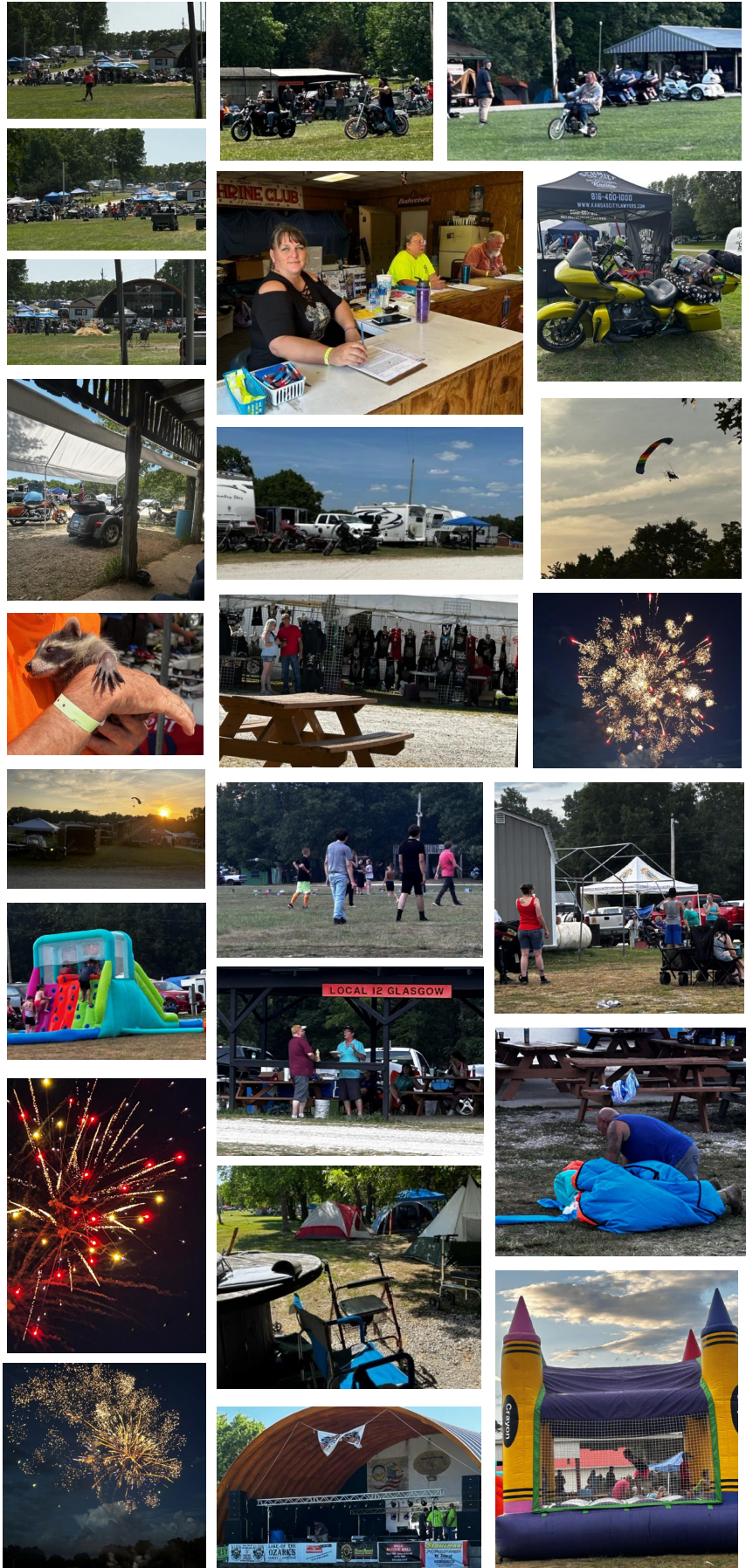

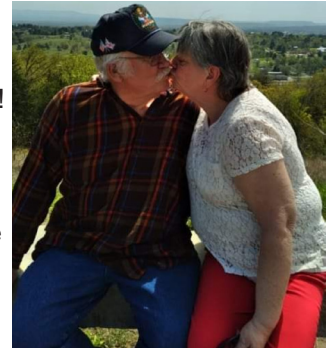
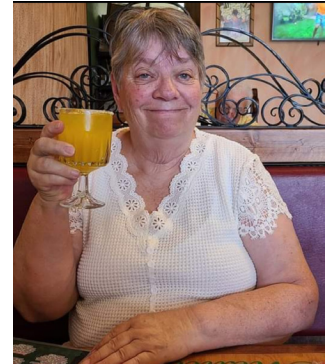

Following is the bi-line of the occurrence.

Four people killed in crash involving a car and multiple motorcycles near Aurora, Mo.

Multiple motorcycle riders have died after a crash involving multiple motorcycles and a car Saturday afternoon on State Highway 39 near Aurora. According to the Missouri State Highway Patrol, four people have died. In total, there were 11 people involved, 10 motorcyclists and the driver of the car. 6 others were hospitalized.

The crash report states the crash occurred when a Toyota Corolla crossed the center line and hit five motorcycles. After the impact, the car then went off the side of the road and stopped in a ditch. The driver of the car was reported to be impaired and with repeated past offences.
