Lincoln Day's will be at the Oasis Convention Center February 20 - 22 in Springfield. You can join Joe and talk to the Republican Reps and Senators. There is a banquet that you attend, make your reservations. 2026 Legislation: SB 990 Motorcycle Helmet Law if it does come up for a hearing, we need everyone to appear. Joe will send out a notification on Facebook when this happens. We need to get members walking the halls again to make ourselves known. SB 1050 Autonomous Vehicles we are against this. SB 1283 Liability risks during motocross activities. Mainly for motocross track owners. SB 1369 Enacts provisions relating to motorcycle (*lane filtering*). Allows motorcycles to drive down the

center line only on a 4 lane highway when it's moving at a slow speed. It's already enacted in 6 or 7 states now. SB 1477 Motorcycle lighting Allows motorcycles to display any color they want as long as they don't flash. Right now only amber and white is allowed. HB 1660 Right to repair for motorcycles. HB 1753 Drivers Education online course. HB1831 Child Safety on motorcycles and motor tricycles. Mandating helmets for kids and also foot pegs high enough for young child to reach. Joe will let everyone know if he needs people to testify on this. HB 2195 Drivers education. Kids in high school. HB 2069 Autonomous vehicles HB 2008 Autonomous vehicles HB 2240 Autonomous vehicles HB 2328 Child safety on motorcycles and motor tricycles HB 2774 Prohibits regulations on the sale or use of certain vehicles, tools or equipment based on fuel source. It's the right to have a gas powered equipment or vehicles. HB 2994 Motorcycle lighting. Same as above. .

I know this is a long list of bills and there have been hearings on three of them already, HB 2069, HB 2208 and SB 1050 all autonomous vehicle bills. I was able to testify in person on the two House bills and send in testimony on the Senate bill. The testimony was in opposition to these computer driven vehicles. They seem to be pushing these autonomous vehicle bills through the process. One reason is that Waymo is already here in St. Louis mapping streets and routes and they are wanting to start operating as soon as possible. At this time Waymo cannot operate without a driver in the vehicle. These autonomous vehicles have not been tested effectively around motorcycles or construction areas. There have been reports of these vehicles failing on many occasions. Approximately six weeks ago one hit a child, the child is fine but it didn’t recognize the child running out in the street. There’s also some other items in this legislation that seems questionable. Please reach out to your legislators and voice your concerns to them by calling or emailing.

As far as the other legislation those items are moving a little slower. Both the helmet bills are not moving and hopefully I have them stopped but anything can happen. SB 1369, the lane filtering bill has been referred to the Transportation committee and I haven’t heard that it will be up for a hearing any time soon. I will try and keep you posted on any upcoming hearings on any of these bills.

As for all you veterans out there, Deanna is working on Veterans issues again this year and if you have any questions about veterans legislation please reach out to her.

Things move fast at times and sometimes there’s not much time to let you know about hearings so keep your eyes on Facebook for quick updates. Thank you and stay safe out there.

MRF Report On The Road Again

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) has officially kicked off its annual Road Show, continuing our commitment to meet riders where they are and ensure the voices of grassroots motorcyclists guide our work in Washington, D.C. Each year, MRF Board Members travel the country attending State Motorcyclists' Rights Organization (SMRO) events to hear directly from riders, learn what issues matter most in their states, and share the updated 2026 MRF federal legislative agenda for the year ahead.

Recently, the Road Show has taken us to Michigan (ABATE of Michigan), Illinois (ABATE of Illinois), Kentucky (KMA/KBA), and Pennsylvania (ABATE of PA), where we spent time listening to bikers discuss the challenges and priorities facing riders in their communities. These conversations are essential to our mission, as they help us connect state-level concerns to federal issues that impact all motorcyclists. Just as importantly, we discussed how riders and SMROs can play an active role in advancing federal legislation that protects motorcyclists' rights nationwide.

MRF President Kirk "Hardtail" Williard, Vice President Jay Jackson, Executive Director Ryan Hubbard, and MRF State Rep. Andy Kelly participated in these early Road Show stops. This should underscore the importance the MRF places on strong state-federal coordination in our advocacy efforts.

We take pride in being an association that meets face-to-face with members across the country, rather than one that relies solely on power brokers in Washington, D.C.
