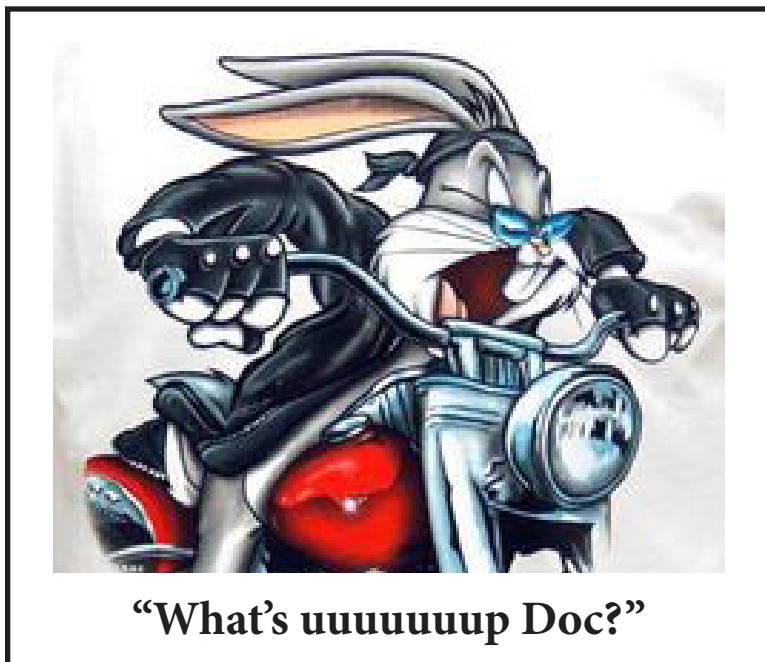

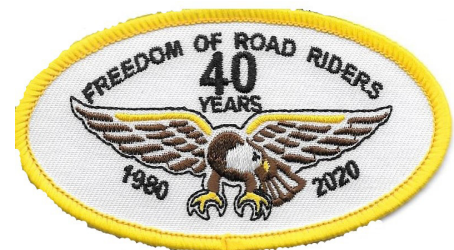

Just wanting to share with you where legislation is in the process so far this year and a few quotes I shared at the FEW Seminar.

Right now, HB 92 is awaiting being placed on the House Calendar and HB 996 is in Rules committee. This is all subject to change next week (March 8 – 12). March 15 – 19 is spring break at the Capitol, which is moot since you will not see this until April. As of this writing I am still working on the MAY Rally and I will keep you posted on the progress. We are planning on having the MAY Rally the 27th or 28th of April. I already have a couple of speakers lined up and should have more soon. I hope to have more information at the FEW and CC meeting. As always if you have questions on legislation do not hesitate to contact me.

On another note I received a message from a person in Iowa asking for our help on some legislation in Iowa. The bill number is HSB 185, and it limits the availability of non-ethanol gas in Iowa. I have not put out a call yet because I wanted more information before doing so, which I am still awaiting on. What I understand so far is that this legislation will limit the number of pumps or eliminate any pumps that have non-ethanol gas, severely limiting choice in Iowa and possibly harming your motorcycle, lawn mowers, or any small engines that are not designed to use ethanol and ruin your motors. For now, look to Facebook for further information.

Getting back to Missouri's legislation we have a couple of bills, HB 92 and HB 996 both sponsored by Representative Jered Taylor, that are moving on redefining autocycles and lighting on motorcycles. Neither of these bills were filed by us but we are supporting and hopeful to see them passed this year. Well, that is all for now and changes come rapidly during session so you can keep up to date with an app that I was told about, and it works well, it is called Fast Democracy and it will keep track of state legislation and federal legislation and notify you of any changes in the legislation you are following. As always be safe out there.

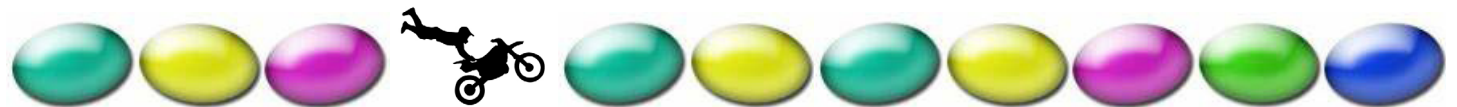

Greetings Riders, another month is upon us and spring is in the air. While it's still a bit cool in the mornings, it is finally getting into decent temperatures for the afternoons and early evenings. The snow is almost all melted, and the chances of ice are fading away to a memory. Still have to be a bit careful in the shady spots early in the morning, but you have to watch out for sand residue on the curves anyway until we get a few good rains. Then we'll only have to worry about dirt and mud from vehicles entering from the side roads.

Between Covid and sub-zero temperatures, there hasn't been a lot to report this year. However, I just received word that we are having the first meeting of the year tonight. As I realize that this Newsletter will take a bit to get out, I will state that the first Eat & Ride and Meeting of the year was held at Tuck Point Bar & Grill in Ravenwood on March 2nd of 2021. If you haven't already begun your riding season, there is no time like the present. Make yourself a list of what your ride needs. Check your tires (air pressure as well as tread condition), change your oil if you didn't before winter. Now is a good time to check the condition of your battery and replace it before you go to all of the events and destinations you have planned. Check your hoses and gaskets, as they might have dried out a bit while you weren't looking and it's easier to repair or replace them at home than on the road. Spring is March 20th, so it won't be long.

Hopefully, the new year will bring an easing of the Covid-19 restrictions and allow us to get out and about more than last year. Vaccination levels are climbing, and more businesses are opening. Some of the small diners and such may be gone for good, but we can still patronize the ones that are open to ensure that they stay that way. Support your local businesses. It will benefit you in the long run.

On a side note. When you get fuel, pay close attention to the fuel mixtures. Many stations are offering a variety of mixtures at multiple octanes. However, some of those have ethanol content in excess of 10%. I don't know of any motorcycles that are recommended to use fuel with more than 10% ethanol. Not good for the health of your ride. Using the wrong fuel could be a costly mistake. Be careful. Personally, I think ethanol belongs in hand sanitizer, for immediate use, or charred oak barrels and should not be removed for at least 10 years. Never in gasoline.

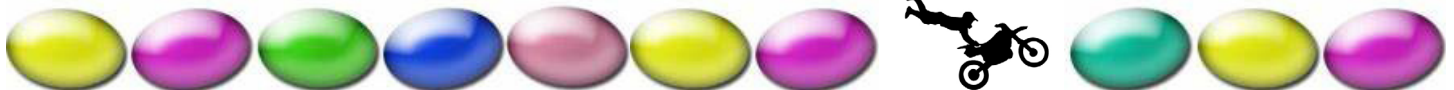

Check your tires for wear and the correct air pressure, check your brakes and brake fluid if it's dark change it, make sure all the lights are working correctly, check and tighten any bolts that may have worked loose (all bikes not just Harleys!).
