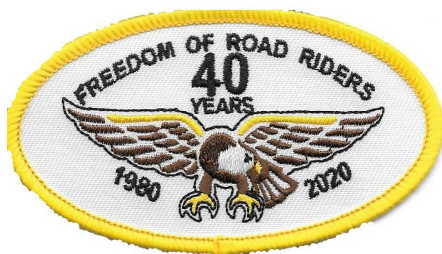

Greetings Riders,

December is upon us again and with it winter is close at hand. The weather lately has been a bit of a mixed bag of warm days mixed in with snow freezing rain and below freezing temps. Some of us got in a few days of riding, but leather was in abundance to stop the wind and insulation and warm clothing to make it bearable. Cold on a motorcycle is just miserable.

Many of us have already put our bikes away for the winter. If you haven't, now is the time to think about winterization. Put some stabilizer in your tank and then make a short run to get it clear through the fuel system. Top off your battery every few weeks or hook it to a battery tender. Notice I said battery tender and not battery charger. Over charging your battery is a good way to end up with a cooked battery in the spring and your riding season is over before it began until you get a new battery. Now is a good time to change your oil so it doesn't sit all winter with whatever impurities have accumulated. It's also a good time to do any of those maintenance chores that got put aside, because the weather was too nice, and you felt like riding more than wrenching.

Our oldest member had a birthday right before Thanksgiving and is now living in Maryville. He tuned 96 and has moved from his R1100RT to a 600cc cruiser. It has a much lower seat and weighs about half as much. He's ridden it to the last few Eat & Rides of the year.

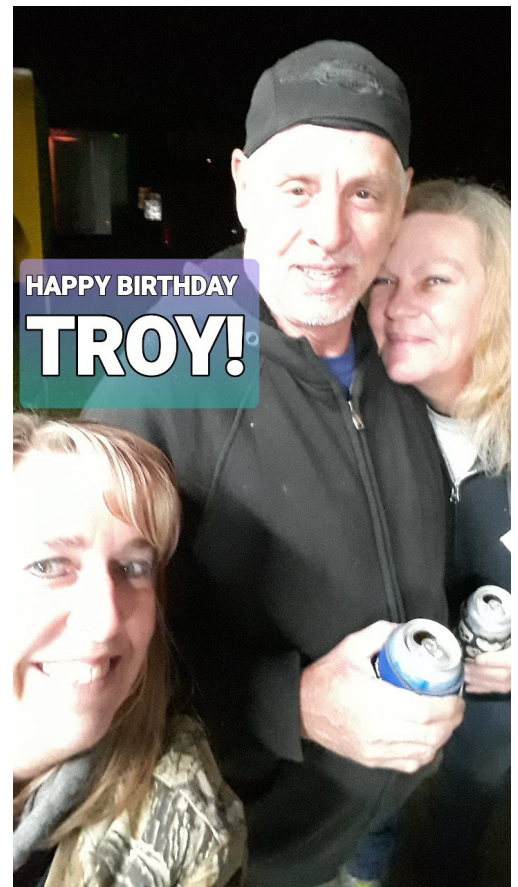

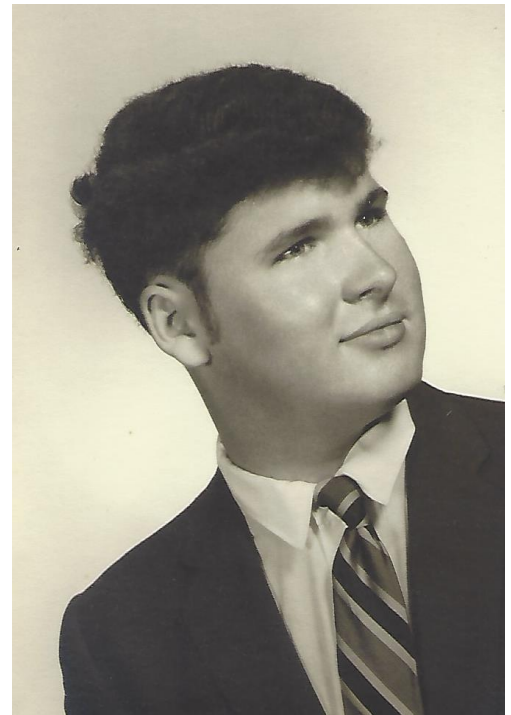
